How It Works

1ST BASE PRESCHOOL & COLLEGE SAVINGS ACCOUNT

Providing the highest quality early child education.



Families can choose from local Home Run certified high quality preschools, which have programming that meets key educational standards. Then, kindergarteners enrolled in the Washington Unified School District who have attended one of the certified high quality early learning preschools will receive a \$50 seed deposit in their new city-sponsored college savings account.

2ND BASE INTERNSHIPS & DIGITAL BADGES

Offering real-world skills acquisition.



High school juniors and seniors enrolled and making satisfactory progress in an integrated college and career pathway in the Washington Unified School District can access paid internships with a local business. After demonstrating certain skills or technical abilities students can earn digital badges, which are online credentials verifying their achievements, to build their resumes, unlock new opportunities and reveal their unique passions.

3RD BASE COLLEGE PROMISE & SCHOLARSHIP

Building a culture of college access and completion.



All West Sacramento graduating seniors will be eligible for up to one year of fee free tuition at a Sacramento City College campus, and a points-based scholarship of up to \$1,000 for college-related expenses.
